Barbara (above) grew up with mostly brothers, and a few cousins. She has been raised by her sick Grandmother, Rhoda, who has fifteen orphans in her home and no one to help her but the Lord and He has given sponsors to many of these children. One of Barbara's sponsored brothers is studying Social Work Administration at Mukono Christian University. She was rebellious in her early teenage years and looks back at it all and laughs. "I felt the world owed me so much because I was an orphan. When HUM came to tell me I got a sponsor I could only think that it was about time. Now I am so grateful to our Lord and HUM and to my sponsor for helping me all these years to become someone who can make a difference." Barbara was one of the kids that hung out in the mango tree and it was a main source of food for her. She did not care about anything because life had nothing to offer her. She felt that if she survived she was unlucky. Now she has hope because she knows the Lord and she believes He is the one that has really helped her.

We are excited about AWANA this year, as we have begun a new program and ask for your prayers. We hope the children will really enjoy it so much and I believe the teachers will too. We are thankful for the support that God has provided for us and that makes it possible to have the AWANA ministry. During the school time we do not have as many children, mostly smaller children, so this has given us new ideas for the ministry. Pray for this ministry to touch many children and their homes where they come from too, as we have seen it do in the past.

This month and last month we have been giving all the children and youth in the ministry new shoes for school. All kids have to wear these black shoes, which I know would never make it in America! We have several new little children who had never worn shoes before. It was so cute and funny to see these little ones trying to walk with their shoes. Three of the little girls were just too small. After putting on the shoes, they could not lift their feet to walk, every step became difficult. We finally had to take the shoes back and look for some very light ones.

Soon after these four girls we had another two young girls come and they had the same problem. Three of the girls do not have fathers and the other two little girls live with an Aunt because their father cannot properly take care of them since their mother died. All but the youngest are going to nursery school because of the help of generous sponsors.
